Pay Scale \$12.00 - \$16.00 per hour based on experience

Qualifications:

- H.S. Graduate or equivalent
- 3 or more years experience working in the field of environmental regulation. An Associate Degree, or higher, in a technical major may count toward two years of experience.
- Must be experienced in water sampling, air monitoring, solid waste management and the implementation of U.S. E.P.A. programs.
- Applicant must have basic computer skills, MS Word, use of Internet, mapping & GPS
- Must have a valid California drivers license

Duties & responsibilities:

- The Environmental Technician reports to the Director or the Director's designee. Applicant will be responsible for assignments related to the acquisition and analysis of information used in protecting the health, safety and environment of the Campo Indian Reservation and surrounding community.
- Applicant will be responsible for the work of technicians, technician trainees, laborers or others that may be assigned from time to time for various projects.
- Applicant must be able and willing to develop and make public presentations and submit regular written reports to CEPA management.
- Applicant must be willing and able to lift up to 50 lbs and work outdoors in inclement weather conditions.
- Applicant must be willing and able to travel for training and conferences, (average one trip every 2 months out of San Diego)
- Other duties as assigned.

Hours:

Regular 8-hour day between 7:00AM and 5:00PM, Monday through Friday. Occasional work outside of normal working hours may be required based on need.

This is a Tribal/Indian Preference position. All employees must be willing to submit to random drug testing.
